Vellum soiled and dusty, title page dustsoiled, some marginal stains at pages 9, 21 and 28. Small loss of paper at leaves 317/18 and 319/20 resulting in the loss of only a few letters, not interfering with legibility, some neat old underlining at some pages, notwithstanding these defects still a good/fine copy. From the library of George Montagu esq. (probably from the 1806 sale of his library), with his copper engraved heraldic ex-libris tipped on at the first paste down. USTC n° 21170 (Baudrier vol. 3 pp 454). A collection of tales entitled " Printemps" , in facetious contrast to the author's own name, which are set in a Poitevin country house. The first edition was from 1572 (in Paris) .
