Comment: First of three Frankfurt editions in the 17th century. The main work of the Neapolitan advocate first appeared under the title *Dies geniales* shortly before his death in Rome in 1522. Alessandri wrote this compilation with references to philology, classical studies, law etc. on the model of Gellius' *Noctes atticae* and Macrobius' *Saturnalia*.
